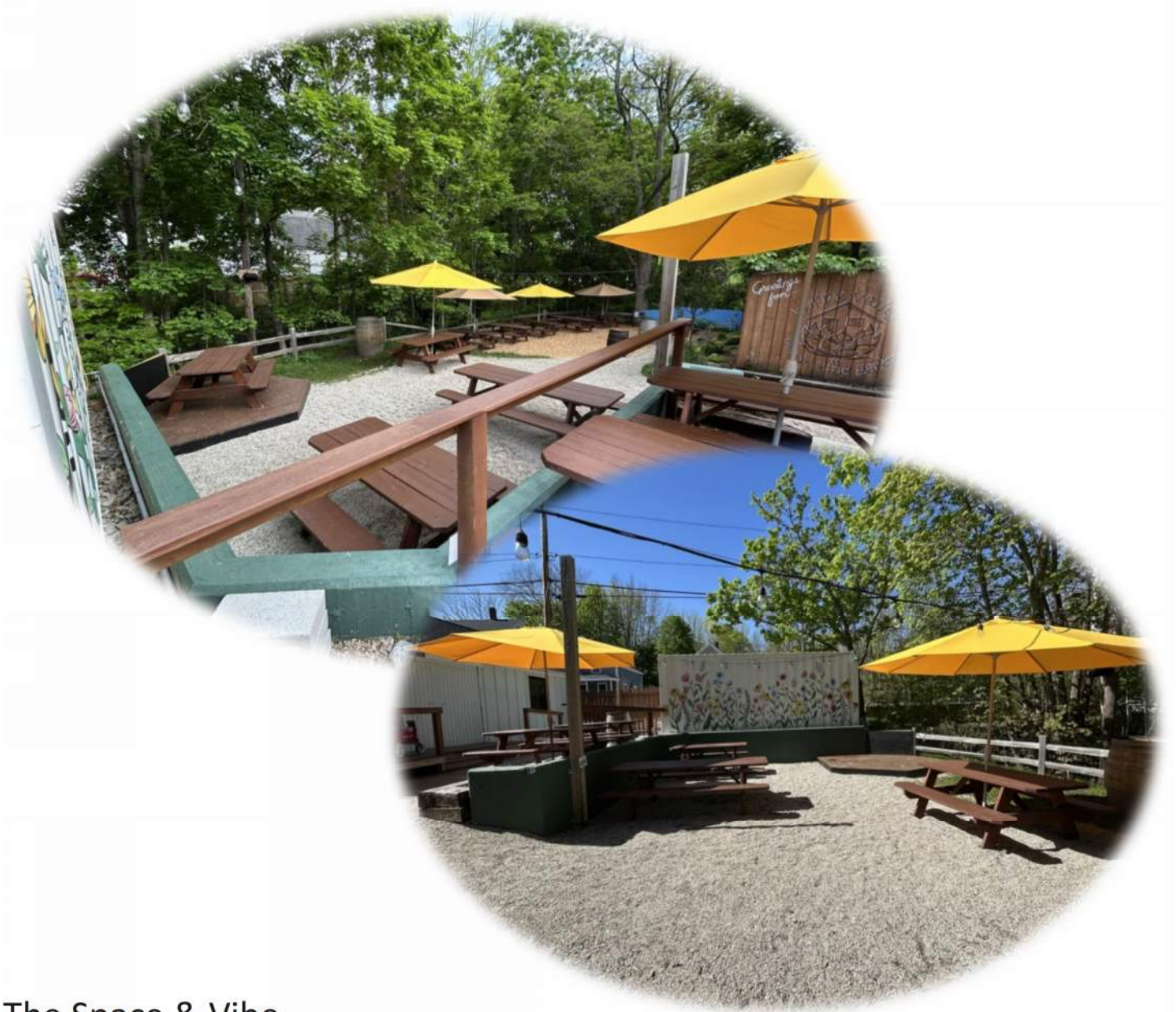


Happy Valley Beer and Wine Garden

The Space & Vibe

Thanks for your interest in performing at Happy Valley.

We are South Berwick's first and only beer and wine garden. We are located on Lower Main Street along Driscoll Brook, in South Berwick's Downtown District.

We are a true "third space," somewhere people gather between home and work to create community. We have twelve rotating Maine-brewed drafts, apps, sandwiches, salads, and live music and events all season. Our stage is located on our middle patio. It's a hexagon shape and is sized for a tight trio.

Our vibe is relaxed and conversational. The stage sits within the beer garden, so we keep volumes at a level where the music fills the space without overtaking it.

Our Sound System

Our space is equipped with permanent sound reinforcement. We have a professional digital mixing console which is controlled off an iPad. We also have a portable subwoofer and stage monitor for your use. Our system is sized for the space and structured to provide an immersive live sound experience while not disturbing our neighbors.

PA	5× Polk Atrium 8 SDI 125watt speakers distributed throughout the garden
SUBWOOFER	Mackie SWA1801z 18" 850w active sub (not normally used)
STAGE MONITOR	QSC K8.2 active wedge on stage with custom mix if needed.

What We Provide

In addition to the sound system, we will get power to where you need it, mic your amps (up to 2), and set up your inputs, outputs, and monitor mix. We also have some gear and are happy to lend it in a pinch. Please let us know prior to your performance if you will need any of the following items that we have:

- 1× Sennheiser e835 vocal mic
- 2× Sennheiser e609 amp / instrument mics
- 1x Radial Engineering Pro48 Active DI Box
- 2× boom-type mic stands
- 1× straight/round base mic stand
- 7x XLR cables (10-20ft)
- 2× XLR to 1/4-inch TRS cables
- 4-channel analog XLR snake (ethercon in/out)

You Must Bring

In general, everything to hook up to the PA.

- Instruments
- Pedal Boards
- DI boxes
- Drum kits (**Electric drum kits preferred**)
- Guitar/bass amps*
- Vocal microphones
- Mic Stands

***Please note:** If you want to use your own guitar amp, they must be run at a fairly low volume. We will connect to their output or mic them and put everything through the PA.

Before the Show

For solo/duos, a 30-minute setup time is sufficient. Trio and more, 45-minute setup time is a safe bet. Not required, but feel free to send us an input/output list and fill out the attached stage plot to help us make your setup easier.

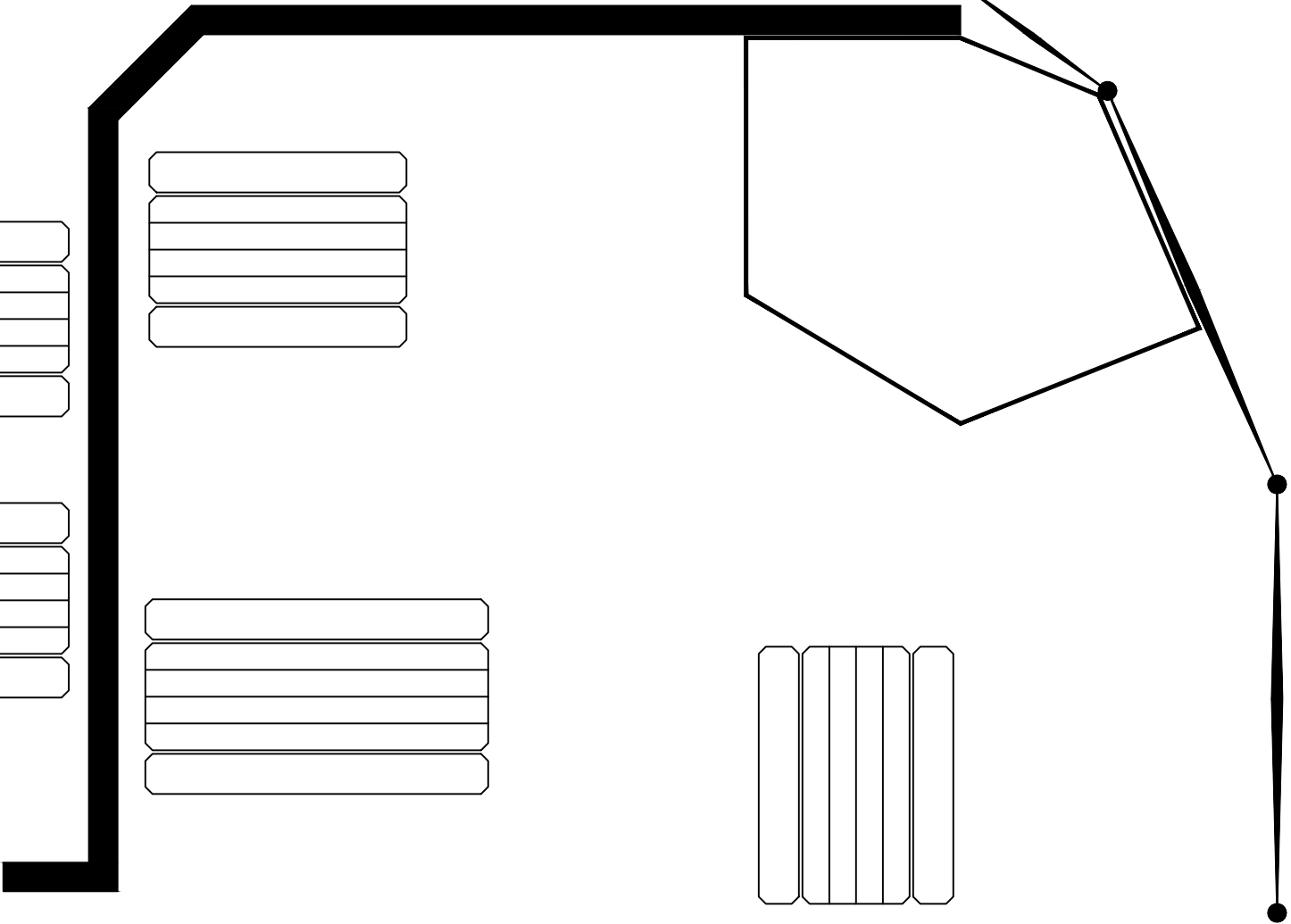
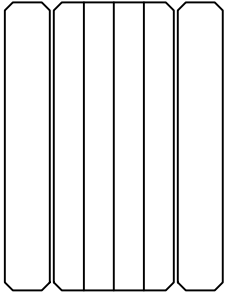
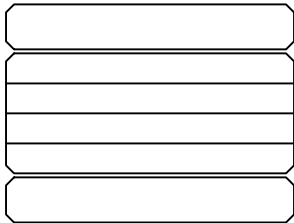
